(There is an extra charge added to our consult fee for out of hours calls which starts at £90 - cost will be explained over phone during your call).

In patients:

All patients receive the highest standard of care however it is not possible for a person to be on site 24hrs a day so we have a camera in which the vet can access from anywhere to check up on hospitalised patients.

Complaints handling procedure:

All complaints received will be acknowledged and resolved in an efficient and timely manner.

Second opinions and referrals:

If a procedure cannot be carried out within the practice, then the owner will be notified that the patient can be referred onto a practice which can carry out the procedure.

Use of client data:

All client information is confidential unless the client makes a specific request, such as data shared to laboratories for submission of samples. If you wish to discuss your data at any time, please contact the clinic.

Access to and ownership of records:

Prescriptions

Prescriptions are available from the practice on request. Please speak with a vet directly to discuss your request. Prescriptions have an administration charge of £13.00 per prescription which is per drug. Additional prescriptions for multiple medications are priced at £7 per medication.

We can only provide prescriptions for Prescription Only Medicines for animals under our care.

We must see your pet for a consultation before we can write the prescription in the previous 6 months from the request. Prescriptions are valid for a maximum of 6 months and often less than this depending on your pet, the condition and the medication being prescribed.

A prescription may not be appropriate if your animal is an inpatient or immediate/emergency treatment is required.

You will of course be informed, on request, of the cost of any medicine that your pet requires.

We have a general policy in this practice to reassess an animal requiring repeat prescriptions at least every 6 months. This can vary with individual circumstances and can vary due to; the condition in question, severity, multiple

conditions, new conditions, changes in drug licencing and multiple medications required can be factors in frequency of rechecks. The approximate standard charge for a re-examination is £40.00.

Patient Note Taking

During your consultation the vet may use a dedicated App for note taking which uses voice recording software to specifically take notes on your pet's condition. If you would rather this is not used please let us know.
